

SAFEGUARDING REQUIREMENTS FOR CLUBS

Following the Annual General Meeting of the British Crown Green Bowling Association in January 2018. It was passed that all clubs must have a named Safeguarding Officer who shall have a DBS (Disclosure and Barring – Services) certificate. This Bye Law will take effect on 1st March 2019.

Any club failing to comply with this will have an appropriate penalty applied.

YCCGBA are currently working with the district safeguarding officers (formerly known as Welfare Officers) to arrange local district association meetings to enable completion of application forms for DBS certificates.

At those meetings further information about support that is available to club safeguarding officers.
